- TCSI Analytics
 - TCSI Analytics reports were due to be released in November
 - A smaller number of these reports are currently being tested and will now be available in December
 - All other TCSI Analytics reports will be delayed until 2022
- ATO Loans Processing
 - We have temporarily suspended loans being sent to the ATO

Scheduled Validations

- Scheduled Validations coming in November and December
 - Unit Enrolment Census Date SV00001 – SV00040
 - Unit Enrolment Census Date SV00044 and SV00046
- Large number of validations to be generated
- Correct your data as soon as possible



Scheduled Validations


- Most providers have a large number of scheduled validations clustered around 3-4 notifications
- They are not the same notifications at every provider
- SV00019 – Highest Attainment Code (E620) must be populated.
- SV00035 - Year Arrived in Australia (E347) must be populated for students residing in Australia but born overseas.

Accessing TCSI services (PRODA)

Accessing TCSI services (PRODA)

- The PRODA 'director' role and attributes do not expire
- Access for 'personnel' can only be delegated for up to 12 months
- Delegations can be extended for:
 - Membership of the organisation
 - Each 'attribute' the member required (i.e. TCSI services)
- Directors can delegate the ability to delegate

The holiday season and TCSI

- TCSI systems will continue to operate over the holiday period

Higher Education hot topics

Former permanent humanitarian visa holders

- Eligible former permanent humanitarian holders should be reported under the Citizen Resident Code for permanent humanitarian visa holders

SA-HELP debt incurral dates

- Students must be enrolled to be charged a student services and amenities fee (*s126-1 of HESA*)
- SA-HELP incurral must be after commencement and before the course outcome date

Data verification (HE only)

- **2020 Data** – Expected to be finalised by the end of November
- **2021 Data** – 2021 data is expected to be verified in May 2022
- **2022 Data** – Verification of 2022 data is likely to be brought forward to March 2023
