Re-triggering TFN verification

Why we need to re-trigger

TFN verification starts when sufficient details are available

TCSI then attempts to verify every 24 hours for 12 weeks (84 attempts)

After 12 weeks, TFN verification stops and the notification changes to:

"TFN unmatched and verification period has concluded – TFN will need to be re-reported to recommence verification period"

How it works

A PATCH B2G API call for the affected student record, with the same TFN or name details, will re-trigger another 12 weeks of daily attempts (there is no limit on the number of re-triggers)



How to re-trigger in your software

Your system may not be designed to send a PATCH call when details are the same in your system as in TCSI

For more details on how your solution works, please engage with your vendor and their resources

Plans for TCSI Data Entry

TCSI Data Entry does not support PATCH calls where nothing has changed on a student record

Design work is underway to find a solution (not starting build until concordance is delivered)

We are making name changes for departments and adding a new section for TEQSA users.




GENERAL


The TCSI Data Entry portal has been blocked by large submissions in the lead up to key deadlines:

- Staff data in September
- Apps and offers and PIR Student in November

The outages were caused by large files that generated even larger response files due to multiple validation messages

Investigation is underway to find solutions ahead of April next year (apps and offers due in May)

To reduce risk, please submit files for testing and/or submit a few rows in production to check for systemic issues like formatting errors. Then submit the larger file.



Higher education data verification




Trialling longer verification windows to support more flexible planning
