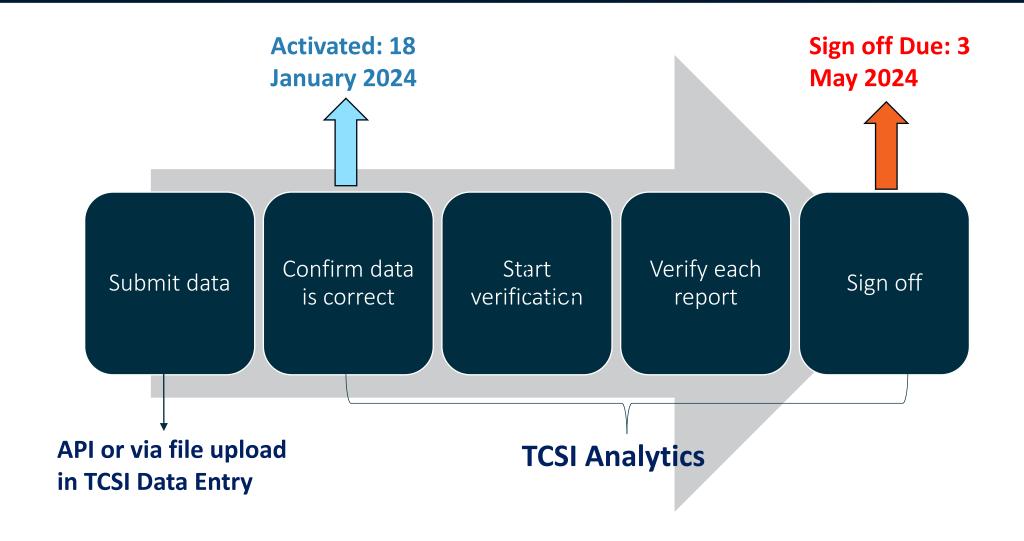

Data Checking:

- Review and verify ALL Verification reports before being able to sign off
- Verification reports are mirrors of the live data report version, until the "Start Verification" button is clicked on.

When changes to the live data report is made after the "start verification" button has been clicked, the "Refresh" button is required to update the verification report

- ➤ Once clicked on *Refresh*, verification report will take overnight to update and capture the latest data. You cannot further verify this report until the next day.
- ➤ Make sure to click on "*Start Verification*" button again when you are verifying again after the refresh.

SLEMS – Vertical Double Degree Processing and TCSI Analytics Reports



1. Vertical Double Degrees

- Under current SLEMS processing for Additional SLE (ALSE), ASLE will not be awarded correctly where:
 - A vertical double degree is reported as an undergraduate course no ASLE will be awarded
 - 2. A vertical double degree is reported as a postgraduate course ASLE will be awarded for the whole degree, rather than the postgraduate component, which is the part that is entitled to ASLE under the SLE Guidelines
- To manage this issue without the requirement to report a new value for all course admissions in TCSI, a new SLE table solution has been developed, and is outlined on the following pages.

2. Vertical Double Degrees

- To correctly assign ASLE to the postgraduate component of a Vertical Double degree (e.g. Bachelor of Arts / Master of Teaching) a new SLE table will be created in TCSI.
- Where SLEMS detects that a course is a vertical double degree (based on inclusion in the table), it will process ASLE using the postgraduate EFTSL amount in the table for that course. Planned fields in the table to process ASLE will be as follows:

3. Vertical Double Degrees – Processing Example

Higher Education Providers supply the Department with information on vertical double degrees they offer, via <u>studentlearningentitlement@education.gov.au</u>, the Department will review and update the table periodically.

Once the table is in place, additional SLE will be awarded to students as follows (example):

- 1. Student A enrols in the Bachelor of Arts/Master of Teaching at a Provider, which is included on the SLE vertical double degree table. In the table, the course has an effective from date of 1 January 2024, with no effective to (end) date. The postgraduate component has an EFTSL value of 1 EFTSL. Student A has not previously consumed any Additional SLE.
- 2. The Course Admission is reported to the Department on 12 December 2023 with a Course of Study Commencement date of 19 January 2024.
- 3. The Course Admission is linked to an entry on the SLE vertical double degree table, and the Course of Study Commencement Date sits within the effective date range on the table, so Student A is awarded 1 EFTSL of Additional SLE (EFTSL value of postgraduate component of the course **minus** and ASLE previously consumed).

The Additional SLE amount is awarded as at 12 December 2023, as it is the earlier of the date the Course Admission is reported to the Department and the Course of Study Commencement Date.

TCSI Analytics Reports

Work is continuing on SLE specific TCSI Analytics reports, which will consist of:

- A Live Data Report a report to outline student SLE amounts and unit enrolment information in bulk
- A Course Coverage Live Data Report a report to outline how the student's enrolments compare to their SLE amounts in relation to the Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP) course load they are enrolled in
