STARTUP-HELP requirements

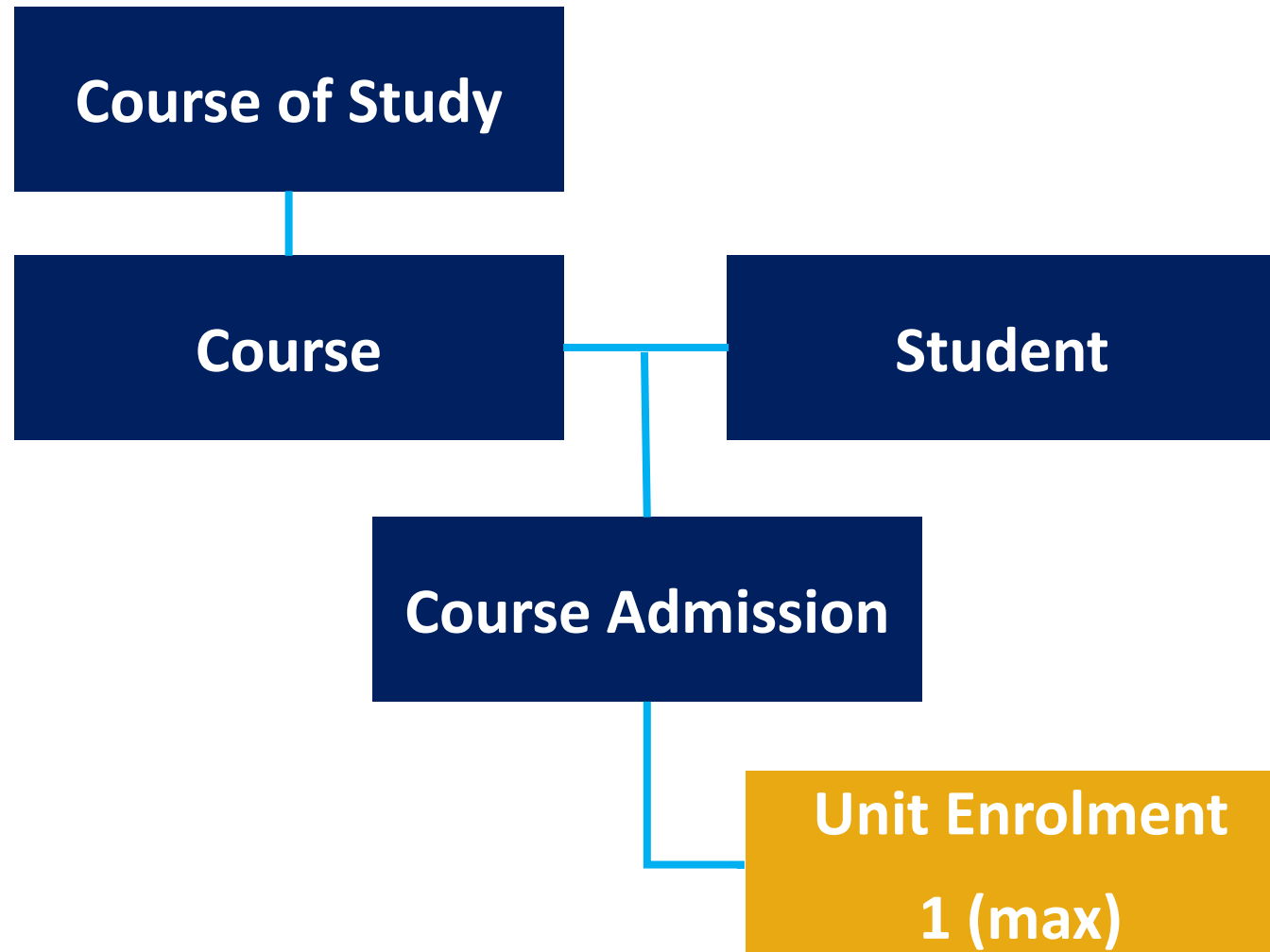
- Providers have been given an allocation of places for the pilot of the Startup Year program.
- Providers must select students for STARTUP-HELP in accordance with the eligibility requirements (see the [Study Assist webpage](#)).
- Full-fee paying domestic or international students may be enrolled into a Startup Year course outside of a provider's STARTUP-HELP allocation.
- Providers will need to ensure they are meeting relevant legislative requirements (see [Startup Year Provider Handbook](#)).
- Providers may not charge full-fee paying students more than the approved course fee.

Overview of TCSI reporting requirements

To enable the reporting of students into a Startup Year course, providers are required to report:

- all students in the Startup Year course with a Student Status Code (E490) of '290'
- a [Course of Study packet](#) with a Course of Study Type ([E310](#)) of '51'
- a [Course packet](#), linked to the course of study.
- **one** [Unit Enrolment packet](#) which should include:
 - the total EFTSL amount for the course, this should be between 0.5 and 1.0 EFTSL
 - the total Amount Charged for the course
 - the census date for the course
 - for students paying via a HELP loan - the total HELP Loan Amount (E558) for the course
 - for students paying upfront – the total Amount Paid Upfront (E381) for the course

Reporting structure for Startup Year courses



Steps for reporting Startup Year in TCSI

Step 1: Report a Course of Study packet, with Course of Study Type ([E310](#)) = '51'.

Step 2: Report a Course packet.

Step 3: Enrol students into the course via the Course Admission packet.

Step 4: Report one unit enrolment with:

- the unit of study census date ([E489](#)) for the course.
- a student status code ([E490](#)) of '290'.
- the total amount of EFTSL ([E339](#)) for the course, between 0.5 and 1.0.
- the total amount charged ([E384](#)) for the course.
- the total amount paid upfront ([E381](#)) or the total HELP loan amount ([E558](#)) for the course.
