TCSI Reference Data for 2025 reporting year

2025 HELP Entitlement limits (HELP balance, OS-HELP and SA-HELP) have now been updated in TCSI

- Unit enrolments with Unit of study census dates (E489) in 2025 that were reported to TCSI prior to 3 October 2024 would not have been assessed against the 2025 HELP Entitlement limits
- If students wanting to access a loan where that loan was reported prior to 3
 October 2024, and was adjusted or rejected, please re-report HELP Loan
 amount E558 for it to be assessed against the new limit.

The TCSI TFN verification Guide has been updated

Student

- can utilise their <u>myGov</u> account to access their <u>ATO account and online services</u>
- ensure their details in myGov matches with the ATO
 - o If incorrect update with the correct details and contact their provider
 - If all correct contact provider to ensure data at the ATO aligns with provider record

Key troubleshooting areas to focus on

- name and reporting fields (including middle name or student give name other)
- DOB (ensure format in TCSI and the ATO matches, i.e., DD/MM/YYYY)
- TFN

Real Time and Scheduled Validations Updates

Real Time and Scheduled Validations Updates

- Earlier in 2024, we compiled a list of all known RTV issues and required updates, based on internal investigations, mailbox queries from providers and discussions in provider working groups.
- The RTV fixes have been gradually released over the last 6 months, with the final set on validations due to be released in November.
- This project had a primary focus on HEP providers although validations affecting VET providers and PIR reporting providers were also taken into consideration.

Real Time and Scheduled Validations Updates

- Over 40 individual RTVs have been enhanced in this six-month period.
- Validations have been delivered in seven tranches, split by priority and packet.
 - RTVs relating to the flow of loans to the ATO
 - Student data RTVs
 - Other Course Admission and Unit Enrolment RTVs
 - Staff RTVs
 - PIR RTVs
 - Any other issues
- The last batch of RTV changes is currently in testing and will be released shortly.

Scheduled Validations Updates

- We undertook a similar approach for the scheduled validations with known issues.
- These were split into three tranches for development:
 - Identity related scheduled validations
 - Payment/discount checking scheduled validations
 - Remaining scheduled validations
- These items are currently in development and will be released to production by the end of February 2025.

Identity Related Issues

- SV00040 update to not require a TFN for a student that only has remitted loans.
- SV00119 update to ensure a USI is not required for students completing enabling courses, cross-institutional and non-award.
- Rationalise USI notifications to cut down on number of notifications against a single student.
 - This will involve taking the 13 current SVs and cutting them down to 5 SVs to only have the critical errors and avoid overlap

Payment/Discount Checking Issues

- SV00099 addition of new E490 codes to reflect post discount years.
- SV00100 addition of new E490 codes to reflect post discount years.
- SV00098 notification not clearing.
- SV00117 New scheduled validation checking charges for the student on a census date.

Miscellaneous Scheduled Validations

- SV00048 update message text for clarity.
- SV00022/SV00023 logical error to be fixed.
- SV00083 logic to be amended so this rule does not apply to enabling, non-award and cross-institutional courses, micro-credential and start-up HELP courses.
- SV00086 notifications not clearing.
- SV00087 updating to ensure only triggers on certain HDR codes.
- SV00026 notifications not clearing.

Other Changes

- USI Verification Improvements
 - Adjust the USI verification triggers to match the TFN verification triggers
 - Allow providers to restart USI verification through a PATCH with no change in data
 - Extend the USI verification period to match that of the TFN verification
- Removal of CHESSN Notifications
 - Remove CHESSN notifications visible to providers
 - Departmental notifications regarding CHESSNs will be kept
- These items will be released to production by the end of February 2025.

2025 changes – Elements From Optional to Mandatory

Data element	Packet	Why we want to change to mandatory
E702: Australian year 12 results type code	Course application	This variable is essential to us as we use to distinguish between school leaver and non-school leaver
E316: Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander code	Course application	This variable is essential as one of the key equity group variables
E559: Campus postcode	Course preference and offers	Some universities have campuses across regional/remote areas. Allows us to know regional/remote counts
E329: Mode of attendance code	Course preference and offers	Provide trend insight on shift from more traditional modes of attendance
E723: Offer response code	Course offers	Crucial for determining acceptances count
