Removal of CHESSN notifications



Removal of CHESSN notifications


- CHESSN notifications will no longer be triggered in TCSI.
- Providers are not required to report, update, or remove CHESSN details in TCSI.
- Attempted changes to CHESSN will be ignored by TCSI other information on the student record will be processed normally.
- TCSI will continue to populate the CHESSN field when the tax file number (TFN) or Unique Student Identifier (USI) verifies
 - If both are supplied, both must verify.




2024 Higher Education Provider (HEP) – Student data verification




Verification Process Overview






Activated

- •Status applies when the department opens a collection for verification.
- •The **START VERIFICATION** button has been enabled for providers to start verification.




Verifying

- •Status after the provider has selected the collection and clicks "Start verification"
- Providers verify by checking the accuracy of the data, one report at a time.




Verified

- •Status after the provider indicates that all reports within the collection have been checked and **VERIFIED**.
- Requires PRODA role:
 TCSI Analytics Verify.



Refreshing


- •Status after the provider selects **REFRESH DATA** to update the reports.
- Providers refresh their reports when errors are detected after starting verification, and the data has been corrected in TCSI live data.
- Refresh is an overnight process and the collection will not be available while the refresh is in progress.



Signed Off

- Status appears when the collection is SIGNED OFF.
- •Requires PRODA role: TCSI Analytics Signoff.
- •RESET REQUEST updates the status to RESET and is used if the sign off was performed in error. The status will return to VERIYED if the department accepts the request.
- •When all providers have signed off, the Collection is **FINALISED** by Education.

- Data needs to be accurate before signing off the Collection(s).
- No changes can be made after your verification reports are signed off and the Collections are finalised by the department.

Scheduled Validations update



Removal of new/updated scheduled validations

Scheduled validations to be removed

- SV00126 checking term address against citizen resident code
- SV00022 checking ATAR for students who recently left school
- SV00023 checking selection rank for students who recently left school

These validations will be returned to production after 2024 HEP Student verification is complete and the validations are functioning as intended.

Please ignore these validations until they are re-released.

Reporting students in FEE-FREE Uni Ready courses

What codes do I report for FEE-FREE Uni Ready students

- FEE-FREE Uni Ready students should be reported in a course with of Course of study type code (E310) of '30'.
- Domestic Commonwealth supported students enrolled in FEE-FREE Uni Ready courses should be reported with a Student status code (E490) of '261'.
- Full-Fee paying students in enabling courses should be reported with a Student status code (E490) that reflects their relevant full-fee paying circumstance, for example:
 - E490= '230' for those deferring all or part of Enabling course tuition fee through FEE-HELP
 - E490= '302' for those who paid full Enabling course tuition fee.

What are the changes?

- A proposed minor change to the Student status code (E490) to update the allowable value description for '261' reflecting the introduction of the FEE-FREE Uni Ready program in 2025:
 - Code text to read: A domestic student enrolled in an enabling/FEE-FREE Uni Ready courses (i.e. bridging or supplementary programme)
