# Verified USI requirement for link between eCAF and TCSI



# Verified USI requirement for link between eCAF and TCSI

- The TCSI system now automatically retrieves TFNs from eCAF where:
  - a student record already exists in TCSI
  - there is a verified TFN for the student in eCAF.
- Scheduled validation (SV) <u>SV00128</u> will trigger for providers when a TFN cannot be found by the reporting deadline:

'A TFN cannot be found for the student. Please ensure there is a verified TFN and USI in eCAF, and the provider student ID, USI, and date of birth data in TCSI exactly matches that in the student's eCAF'.

- Note that a verified USI is required for an exact match to occur between the eCAF record and student record.
- If you experience any issues, first check that the USI is verified in eCAF and TCSI, if issues

- Providers seeking further information about records within their VET Student Loan (VSL) Payment Report may find useful information in the TCSI Analytics 'Provider notifications report'.

- If there is an error with the data you have reported to TCSI, and you are unable to resolve it with your vendor, the VET payments team are able to refer your issue to the TCSI Support team.

- If you trigger <u>RTV10723</u> or <u>RTV10736</u> errors, please consult TCSI support at <u>TCSIsupport@education.gov.au</u> for IT intervention and specify:
  - the concording and master E313 values or include the response file in your correspondence.

## 2025 Staff data verification


#### **Legislative requirements:**

- For **Universities**, staff data submission and verification are part of providers' reporting requirements under the *Higher Education Support Act 2003* (HESA). In scope <u>staff</u> need to be reported and verified as part of the staff data verification process.
- For all other higher education providers, staff data submission and verification are part of providers' reporting requirements under the *Tertiary Education Quality and Standards Agency Act 2011* (TEQSA) and form part of the TEQSA provider information request. In scope <u>academic staff</u> need to be reported and verified as part of the staff data verification process.

• The current HDR RTP scholarship summary report displays unique **student** counts rather than scholarship counts.

- To more accurately reflect HDR RTP scholarship data that has been reported, the enhanced HDR RTP scholarship summary report will display unique **scholarship** counts.
- Multiple scholarships will appear for a student enrolled in multiple courses and receiving multiple RTP scholarships, regardless of whether they are major or minor courses.
- The "(Not Provided)" column has been removed.
- There is no change to underlying data.

# E487: Scholarship type reminder

Since 2021, only the following values are allowable for <u>E487: Scholarship type</u>:

- 09 A student receiving a Research Training Program (RTP) Fees Offset
- 10 A student receiving a Research Training Program (RTP) Stipend
- 11 A student receiving a Research Training Program (RTP) Allowance

Providers who reported historic values for the 2024 reporting year have been requested to amend their TCSI data.

## E560: Credit used value

- <u>Research block grants</u> (RBGs) are calculated using 2 years of the most recently available research and development income and higher degree by research (HDR) student completions data.
- The department has been contacting providers for information on the circumstances of completions where timeframes appear shorter than expected in the 2024 reporting year.
- To assist the department in identifying the reasons for shorter than expected completion timeframes, providers are asked to ensure they report the EFTSL value of any credit/ recognition of prior learning used towards the requirements of the course under E560: Credit used value.
  - ✓ Reduce provider workload
  - ✓ Streamline verification processes

# Reminder about E623: RTP stipend amount

- Starting from the 2025 reporting year, <u>E623: RTP stipend amount</u> is being changed so that all
  providers should report the annual full-time equivalent amount regardless of whether a
  student has completed their course part-time or completed their course early in the year.
- RTP allowances, RTP fees offsets, and top ups/co-contributions should be excluded from E623.



**Example A:** A student commences their HDR studies in **July** 2025 and is studying full-time. They are awarded a RTP stipend and receive \$20,000 in their bank account in 2025. The annual full-time equivalent RTP stipend rate awarded to the student is \$40,000 in 2025. A RTP stipend rate of \$40,000 is reported in E623.



**Example B:** A student commences their HDR studies in January 2025 and is **studying part-time**. They are awarded a RTP stipend and receive \$20,000 in their bank account in 2025. The annual full-time equivalent RTP stipend rate awarded to the student is \$40,000 in 2025. A RTP stipend rate of \$40,000 is reported in E623.
