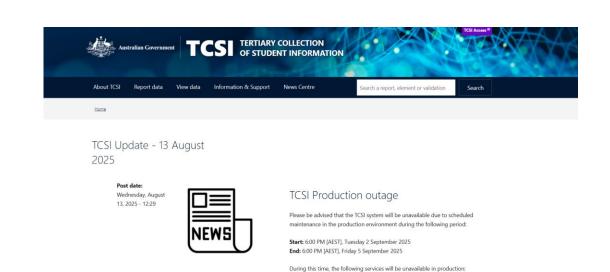

TCSI Production outage

 Providers were notified on 13 August 2025 that the TCSI system will be unavailable due to scheduled maintenance in the production environment:

Start: 9:00 PM [AEST], Tuesday 2 September 2025 **End**: 6:00 PM [AEST], Friday 5 September 2025.

- Impacted systems:
 - TCSI Data Entry portal
 - TCSI APIs
 - TCSI Analytics portal
 - myHELPbalance
- Providers will be notified when the TCSI system is restored and or if there are any delays post 6:00pm 5 September.

We recommend planning ahead to avoid disruption to your activities.

myHELPbalance outage



- myHELPbalance will not be available for students and providers to check available HELP balance information during the outage period.
- We recommend that providers communicate this outage to their students, especially those with census dates that fall within this outage to ensure they check their available HELP balance before their census date.
- If a student does not have sufficient available HELP balance by their census date, they must pay the remaining tuition fees upfront to their provider by the census date to remain eligible for the Commonwealth assistance they are requesting.

Data privacy reminder

TCSI Support would like to remind providers to consider their own privacy obligations and consider the 13 Australian Privacy Principles outlined under the Privacy Privacy Principles outlined under the Privacy Act 1988 when sending data via email to TCSI support.

When emailing TCSI Support

If student information needs to be shared with the department, please send:

• <u>E313: Student identification code</u> (or UID8) and <u>E306: Provider code</u>

TCSI support will request more information if needed and provide a secure channel.

Giving providers more staff controls in TCSI Analytics

TCSI Renewal team is designing a new PRODA attributes structure to split:

- VET and higher education data at dual providers
- student and staff data at higher education providers.

You may start to see new attributes in PRODA. They will not give access to any new or different functionality until after we have shared more information at the monthly webinars, newsletter and in the PRODA guide.

When using the TCSI test environment

Actual live or production data should **not** be used in the test environment. More information at <u>Testing for providers</u>.



Changes to bulk data extracts

Bulk data extracts

Test environment

- The test environment extracts are very limited and should be requested for specific information types (e.g. students or course admissions)
- The test environment has an 800-row limit for extracts.

Production

- Extracts will be unavailable during the outage
- After the outage, you can use the same extract request available on the Request a data extract page
- Bulk extracts will be available on the FTP site as a zip file and will need to be unzipped by the provider
- The initial zip version will be missing TFN and USI verification status on student extracts

On 24 September 2025, the TCSI Data Entry Portal will remove redundant TFN reporting functions for VET providers.

- Higher Education templates and schemas are not impacted.
- A new student file upload template will no longer include a TFN field (E416).
- Functionality to edit TFNs on student VET records will be removed.
- There is no change to TFN obfuscation in the "Records" screen. Providers will still be able to determine whether a TFN exists and has been verified by the ATO:
 - an empty space means TCSI does not have a TFN for the student
 - ######### means TCSI has a TFN and it is verified
 - OOOOOOOO means TCSI is in the process of trying to verify the TFN with the ATO
 - XXXXXXXXX means TCSI has a TFN but it has failed verification checking

This change was initiated by VSL Branch in DEWR and largely concludes work to cease use and disclosure of TFNs by providers that started earlier this year.

Obfuscate TFN in the Data Entry Portal

 Where a student has previously provided a Tax File Number (E416), this will remain obfuscated.

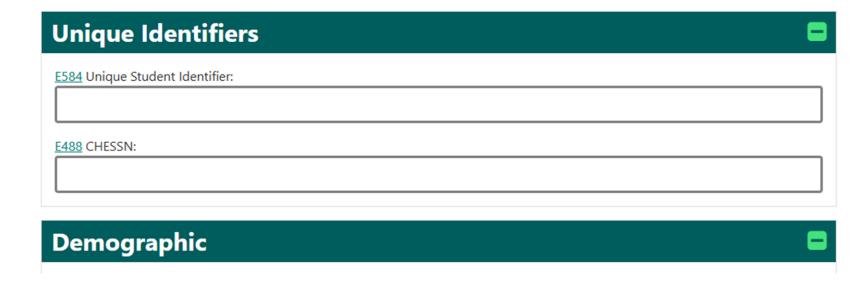

Remove the ability to provide a TFN in the Data Entry Portal

 When editing a current student's details, or adding a new student, there is no longer a TFN field (E416), under the Unique Identifiers heading.



Remove TFN (E416) from the VET file upload template

 The current VET file upload template includes the Tax File Number field (E416), which will be removed

Implications for provider's student management systems

- As uploads of older templates will not be accepted, SMSs may need to change how student packet content
 is generated to include in the new template.
- Providers can now test whether their new templates will work by emailing <u>TCSIsupport@education.gov.au</u>

Warnings for API users

Remove the ability to provide a TFN in the B2G channel

 Where vendors attempt to upload Tax File Numbers in the B2G channel, they will encounter a validation preventing them from doing so.

ITSP Error Code	Error / Description
10938	Validation error 10938 Attempt to report, amend or remove a Tax File Number (E416) Related to element(s): E416, UID8

Implications for provider's student management systems

- This error will only cause the upload of TFNs to fail. Other data items will be uploaded successfully, even if the TFN error is triggered.
- If a provider's SMS is still uploading TFNs through the B2G channel, this will need to end to avoid triggering the error.
