Critical Student Loan Errors Dashboard

- Update

Higher Education - Critical Student Loan Errors Dashboard

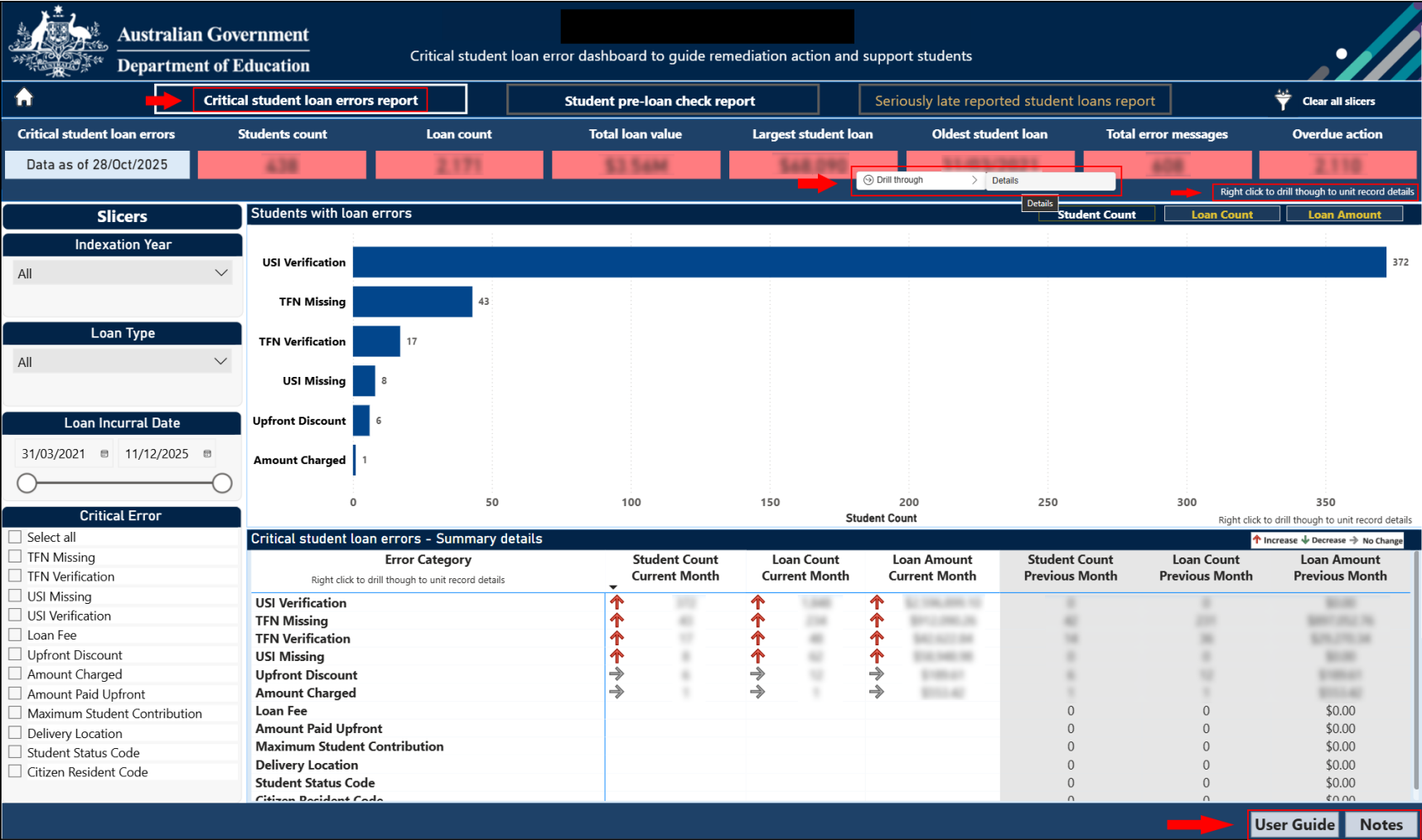
'Guiding provider remediation action to improve support to students'

Critical student loan errors report	Focused on critical data errors in student loan records that require provider action to ensure release and avoid impact on students.
Student pre-loan check report	Reviews partial data records that may be linked to student loans and may require provider action to ensure release and avoid impact on students.
Seriously late reported student loans report	Student loan records submitted well outside legislative mandated deadlines to support provider outreach to affected students.
Notes	Data definitions, context and sensitivities.

- **Identify** and **prioritise** critical data submission errors that prevent or delay loan transfers to the ATO
- **Monitor** and **address** seriously late-reported student loans that may impact students' financial well-being
- **Track progress** over time through trend indicators, supporting continuous improvement and accountability.

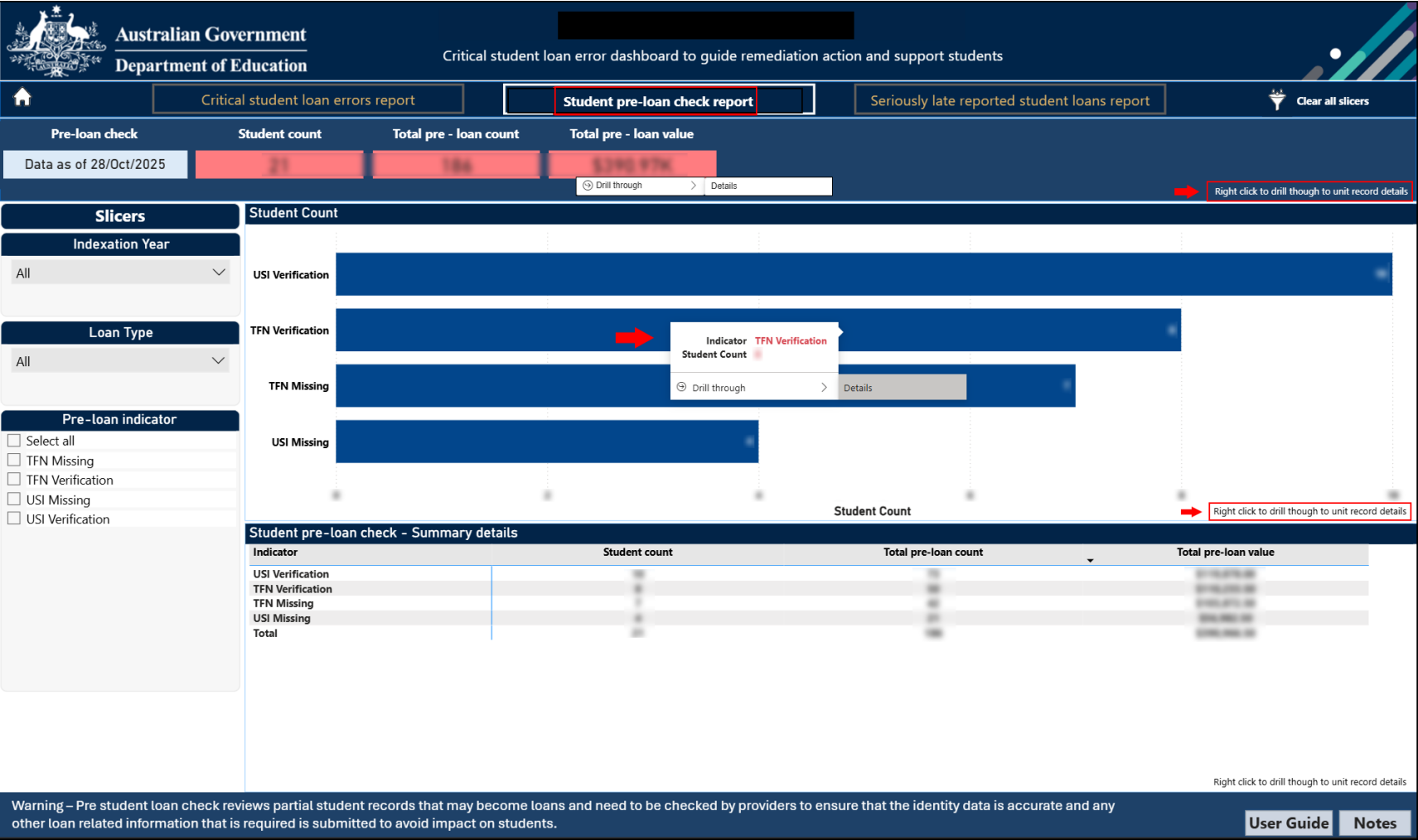


Focuses on **critical data errors** in student loan records that require provider action to avoid impacts on students and to enable transfer to the ATO.

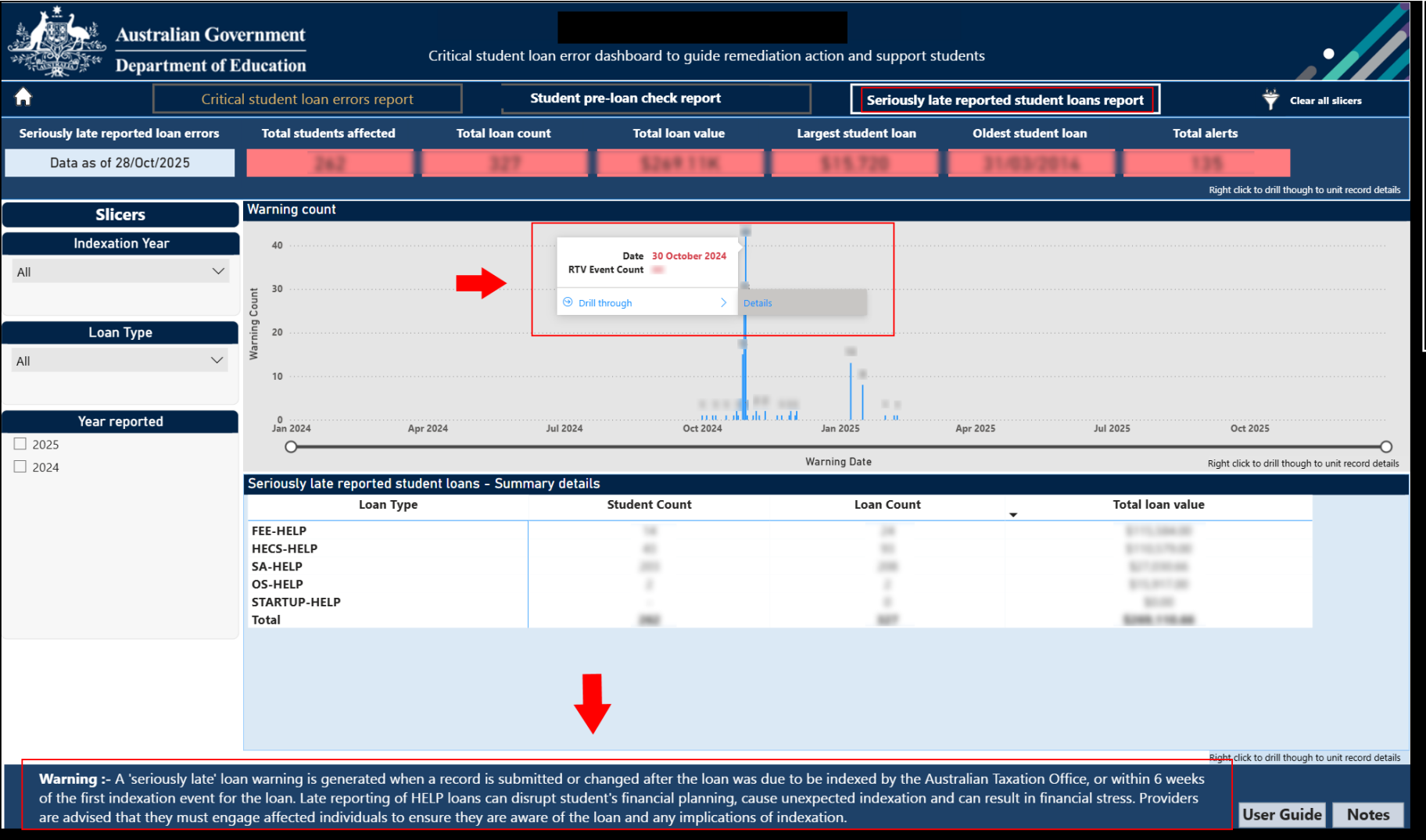

Reviews **partial/precursor unit enrolment records** that may require action to avoid downstream impacts.

Critical Student Loan Errors Dashboard - Update

Highlights student loan records submitted well outside mandated deadlines, supporting timely provider outreach to affected students.



Expected Trends Dashboard - update

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Expected Trends New and Updated Features

The expected trends feature has been enhanced with:

- A Commonwealth Supported Place filter, enabling users to select whether students are within a Commonwealth Supported Place or not.
- Improvements to map functionality
- Provider drill-through capabilities
- Pre-census EFTSL data

Future enhancements planned:

- Inclusion of liability status details, such as HECS-HELP and FEE-HELP statuses

TCSI Analytics –Upcoming 'Staff' Attribute

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TCSI Analytics – Upcoming 'Staff' Attribute

New Attribute: *TCSI Analytics – Staff*

- Grants access to all staff collection analytic reports

This attribute is visible in PRODA but will remain inactive until additional TCSI configuration is complete.

Reason for this change:

- **Provider feedback to separate student and staff data views to:**
 - Enhance privacy and security measures.
 - Limit unnecessary access and reduce the risk of misuse.

Required action:

- No immediate action is needed.
- Further communication will be provided prior to activation.

TCSI data access and bulk data retrieval solution

Rollout

- Over the past several weeks, the TCSI bulk data retrieval solution trial has been communicated to providers who have requested TCSI data extracts via existing processes since September 2025.
- If your organisation has not been engaged and needs access to a bulk data retrieval solution, please email TCSIsupport@education.gov.au.
- We aim to cease the existing TCSI data extract request process by the end of November, so we encourage you to engage with us before **14 November 2025** to minimise any delays.

Higher Education reporting requirements

Reporting timeframes – vital to funding and financial reconciliation

- 2025 Student (HESA approved) – verified data **due 17 April 2026**
- University Applications and Offers
 - Preliminary Collection – *Tertiary Admission Centres ONLY* – **due 12 February 2026**
 - Final Collection – *Universities and Tertiary Admission Centres* – **due 28 May 2026**
- 2026 Staff (HESA approved) – verified data **due 26 June 2026**
