# TCSI System updates



## Address checks in TCSI

- Updated address validations may return errors for valid addresses
- Addresses that have been recently added or updated on the Geocoded National Address File (G-NAF) are most likely to be affected



## Real time validation 10435 set to 'warning'

- Commonwealth supported students cannot have a work experience in industry unit as their first unit in their course
- Transfers to related courses and cross-institutional study mean the fatal validation was blocking some valid use cases
- Please track the warnings to confirm your scenarios are valid



- All VET users require **TCSI Analytics – Read**
- Higher education users will get targeted access based on their combination of attributes
- Some users will lose access to reports from late May if action is not taken
- The release date will be added to the TCSI tracker “TCSI Analytics section” prior to release





### Critical Student Loan Error Dashboard

Guiding provider remediation action to improve support to students – including data submission errors that must be addressed to facilitate the transfer of loans to the Australian Taxation Office and insights on seriously late report loan records that may trigger compliance action.

### Higher Education Student Enrolment Trends

Assisting provider to identify early trends and missing, incomplete or inaccurate student information that may impact funding

Student Headcount Report	Analysis of student enrolment trends by headcount – without consideration of an individual's status as a part or full-time student.
Student Load Report	*Analysis of student enrolment trends by equivalent full-time student load – for student support or funding purposes.
Student Liability Report	Analysis of student enrolment trends by liability status – including Commonwealth supported and full fee-paying students.
Notes	Data definitions, user obligations, context and sensitivities.

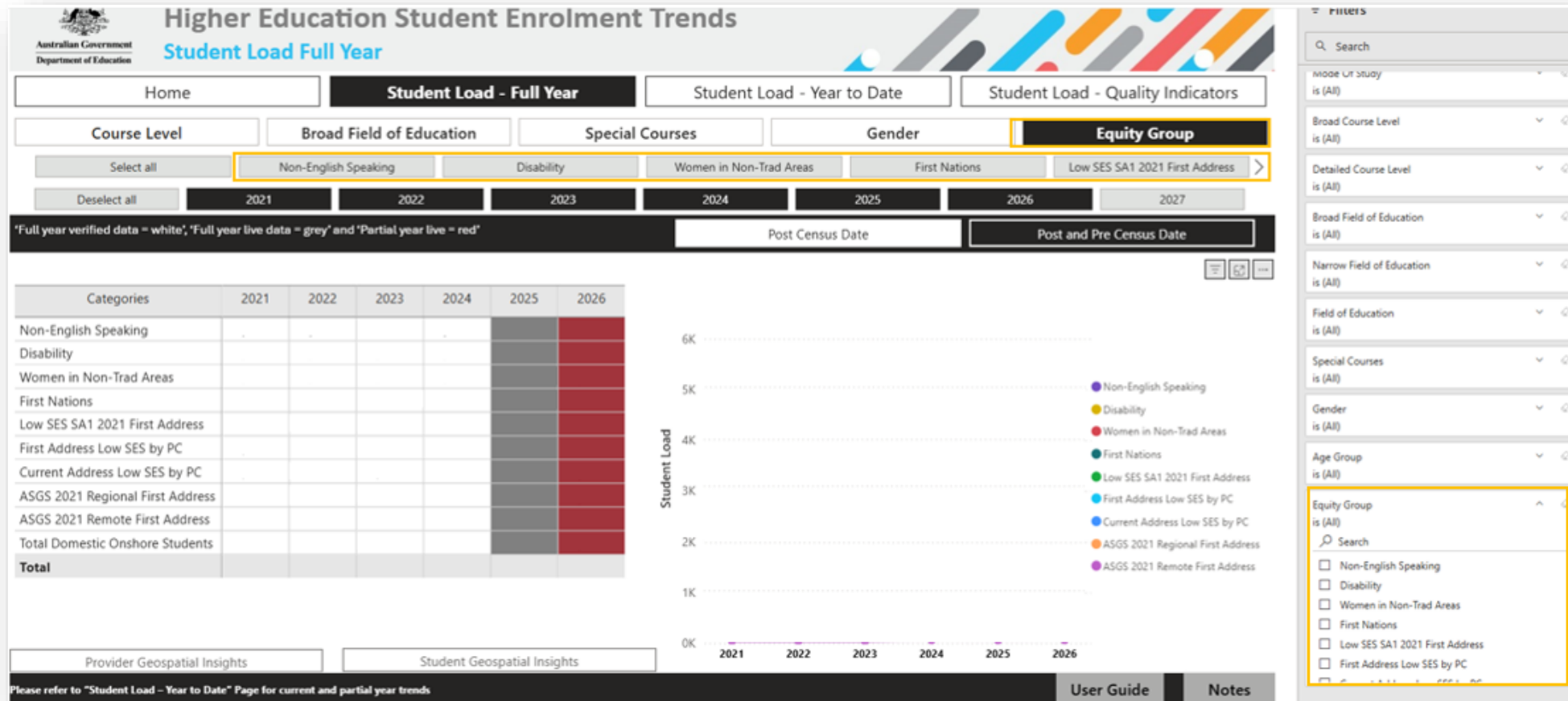

- Targeted 2026 Staff data submission and verification webinar to be held on 20 May 2026
- 2026 Staff collection is due on **26 June 2026**

## Key dates for the collection

- Reference date: 14 May 2026
- Final data due: 28 May 2026
- Who this applies to: Table A and Table B universities and Tertiary Admissions Centres (TACs)

# Identifying Current Year 12 Applicants

## **What we mean by “Current Year 12”**

- Students who were in Year 12 in the year immediately before the reference year

## **How we identify them**

- Using E702 – Australian Year 12 result type code

## **How the codes are used**

- E702 = 01-08 → Current Year 12
- E702 = 09 → Non-Year 12 (Year 12 attempted earlier)

## **Important reminder**

- If Year 12 was attempted in a previous year, E702 must be coded as 09
- Incorrect coding can misclassify students and affect reporting
